

Accessibility for All

York and District Indoor Bowls Club encourages participation of people with all abilities to bowl at the club. We will aim to include all members and can best serve your specific needs through individual discussion on how we can best assist you.

There is a large car park at the front of the building and we have several disabled spaces close to the main entrance and entry to the club is via a shallow slope to a push button door to gain access to the building or via the steps.

Once in, the main facilities are signposted. The Office is to your left, just past the Bar, the Restaurant is to your right. The Bowling area is straight in front of you, via a slope (or by steps from the Office). The Toilets are past the bar down some steps, however there is a disabled toilet next to the entrance door.

Entry to the Rinks are either through the wheelchair friendly access gaps or by stepping over the ditch surrounding the green. Please use the safety handles when accessing the Rinks in this way.

A weekly Boccia and Bowling session for people with impairments runs all year round on Wednesday from 1pm to 2pm (approx). For an overall guide to the Club (including safety information) please see our Welcome Guide.

We have specially adapted wheelchairs for use on the rinks, but if you are unable to transfer then we can make arrangements to use your own wheelchair on the rinks.
